

FROGS: POOL SET-UP for HOME MEET



VISITING TEAM AREA

- For ALL lounge chairs on concrete deck, stack against the fence, no more than five (5) chairs high;
- Move tables close to fence, on concrete Pool Deck near Baby Pool Fence & Back Fence junction;
- Remove ALL white plastic chairs from Storage Room; set in three (3) rows where green loungers are usually located on concrete deck.

COMPUTER OPS/RIBBONS (OLD POOL PAVILION AT BATHHOUSE ENTRANCE)

- Four (4) long tables from Storage Room set-up under small pavilion at bathhouse;
 - Two rows of two (2) tables perpendicular to the bathhouse:
 - One row against the columns closest to the new pavilion;
 - One row under the ceiling fan and light.
- Eight (8) green pool chairs (from deck near baby pool) situated with 4 chairs on each side of the one table row (Computer Ops);
- Two (2) green chairs against the other row of tables on inside of Pavilion (Ribbons);
- Cord to outside shower pulled up out of children's reach (to protect computer and other electronics).

STARTER / ANNOUNCER AREA

- One (1) long table from storage set against fence at deep end of pool between guard stand and back deck (Starter);
- One (1) round table with umbrella set at small gate against deck/pavilion ramp fence at deep end of pool between guard stand & back deck and adjacent to the long table (Announcer).

SWIMMER SEEDING AREA (A.K.A. CLERK OF COURSE)

- Back Deck Loungers moved close to the new pavilion ramp & step areas. NONE in area of ramp from asphalt drive;
- Back Deck Tables moved (compressed) toward pavilion steps/ramp to make space for benches for Clerk of Course/Seeding Area;
- Eight (8) wooden benches (two-board seat area bench; *not the 3-board benches under the pavilion*) set on back deck perpendicular to the back deck railing;
- White Tent moved or assembled over benches on back deck.

TIMERS/ RECORDERS / COACH AREAS

- Four (4) green chairs (from deck at baby pool) at **Deep End** of pool lanes;
- Four (4) green chairs (from deck at baby pool) at **Shallow End** of pool lanes.

COACH / STROKE AND TURN OBSERVATION AREAS (LENGTH OF POOL)

- Move shallow end Guard Stand “L” at Diving Well across from other Guard Stand;
- Umbrellas on each Guard Stand (set on foot platform until morning);
- Backstroke poles removed from blue barrel in storage room--HEAVY IRON POLES:
 - Short poles set into holes in deck in shallow end at each stair well:
 - FAIR OAKS – facing pool entrance (Fair Oak Drive);
 - Long poles set into holes at deep end:
 - One (1) near Diving Board;
 - One (1) between guard stand and pool end;
 - LANE NUMBERS – face back deck.
- White PVC poles removed from blue barrel in storage room. Poles have “eye” rings midway up height. (4-6)
- Three ropes from storage room near barrel:
 - One (1) on each side of length of pool from stair rail, if possible, to guard stand, incorporating “eyes” in white PVC poles;
 - One (1) across pool from Guard Stand to Guard Stand (false start rope).

CONCESSIONS

- Pavilion Tables & Benches near grills set running length of pavilion deck (~3 tables);
- Benches behind tables at edge of pavilion for ice chests and supplies;
- CHECK FOR PROPANE – refill if needed;
- Haul Ice & Drinks from driveway when delivered during Set Up; place in provided coolers. Store coolers in Storage Room for night.

IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO MEET:

- Speaker stands at back end of pool. Speakers on stands & connected to base on Announcer’s table;
 - One stand behind Announcer;
 - One stand on grass at pavilion concrete steps closest to announcer;
 - Exterior Power cord plugged in in green area between announcer & pavilion steps;
 - Appropriate-language playlist & jack between iPhone/iPod (NOTE: jack wiring for interface between sound system base & iPhone (plug in to “Stereo XXXXXXXXXXXX”));
- Lane lines installed – three (3) white/green & one (1) green Diving Well separator (shortest) (NOTE: Lines are located on reel near bathhouse under blue cover);
- Final Concessions set-up, including hot dog griller;
- In case of inclement weather prediction:
 - Tent assembled/moved;
 - Backstroke flags hung.
